

1 ½ packages of semi-sweet chocolate morsels

(12 oz packages)

1 can of 14 oz sweetened condensed milk

1 ½ teaspoon Vanilla


Butter to spread on dish/Pan Cooking

Spray

Optional:

1 Cup walnuts

Microwave the morsels and condensed milk together on high for 5 minutes. Stir in the vanilla (and walnuts if you decide to use them). Butter or spray baking dish and pour chocolate mixture into dish. Chill for at least 2 hours in the refrigerator. Take out and enjoy!
